How to Trim and Apply Adjust the sole:

- 1 If the user has a removable sole in his/her shoes, use that for marking the correct size on the WalkOn Trimable and WalkOn Flex sole (Fig. 1).
- 2 Cut the trimable sole after your markings. The lateral side should not be cut more than is required, so that the medial part of the spring and ankle does not press against the medial aspect of the foot (Fig. 2).
- 3 Place the sole of the WalkOn under the removeable insole, or add a thin padded layer over the sole of the WalkOn.
